- I. Julia!
  - a. June Event Constitutional Change.
    - i. No change – college won't pass it.
    - ii. So keeping JPC involvement in choosing president with outgoing JE President.
  - b. June Event Proposal from president Jonty looks good.
  - c. Open Meeting next week will be chaired by Paul – assuming he doesn't dodge out of town like some irresponsible, self-centered Yank.
    - i. Meeting at 5.30 in the NCR.
    - ii. Agenda Points: Smoking in the Bar, Explaining the Subcommittee Elections.
  - d. Lights for future ents.
