Minutes of a meeting of the JPC held on 18 January 2009 at 7.30 p.m. in the Junior Parlour.

1 Bop

- Freya announced that profits had been made at the bop of around £150, it was remarked that this was a vast improvement on the last bop at which a loss was made. Members of the JPC pointed out that this was due to better staffing on all bars, on the entrance, and on any other doors people try to sneak in through, and also the fact that the rugby team were made to pay.
- It was pointed out that if certain sports societies did not pay for each bop they attend then the money the JPC usually give to sport societies will not be available.
- It was suggested that at future bops we use a student dj - it was pointed out that this has been suggested by many members of the JP and would make the music at the bops better.
- It was suggested that the JPC apply for a late license for the bar on bop nights to bring in profits for the bar, and also that we talk to senior members about why the bop has to finish at 12.0–12.15 rather than the previous time of 12.30 as stated in the agreement between college and the JPC.
- It was suggested that in future when a new Ents officer is appointed the handing over ents officer should assist the new ents officer with his/her first bop, so that it is a less daunting task and runs more smoothly.

2 University Challenge

- Zami told JPC that she had received the yearly papers for entrance of a team from Pembroke College to University Challenge, she also received

an email from Tom Hammond asking whether he could be in charge of putting together the team, and the JPC agreed that this would be a good idea.

3 JPC charity

- Zami announced that the JPC will hold an Open Meeting for JP members to propose charities to be elected as the JPC charity later on this term.
- Elections for this will be held at the same time as the JPC elections (week 4-5)

4 Semester students

- Zami asked certain members of the JPC to attend a meeting at which the semester students had an opportunity to meet the JPC and ask any questions they might have and to welcome them to Pembroke.

5 JPC posters

- Louise reminded everyone to get their posters done for the JPC notice board as soon as possible, so that the roles of the JPC members was well publicized and easily accessible to all Pembroke students.

6 Open Meeting

- A date for the next JPC open meeting is yet to be set but the agenda was discussed. On the agenda will be JPC charities; hostels; fines; the issue of senior college meeting minutes being available to junior members; bar prices; and a report on progress from the last JPC meeting (food and bar prices have been published in trough and in bar, fence at Selwyn has been put up)
